3. Enhance the Outdoor Education program
4. Increase International Students to 6 per year
5. Fully educate every pastor, youth worker and church about JRHS within a 30 mile radius
6. Well-constructed and organized Alumni Association



FUNDING DEVELOPMENT

1. Increase Faculty compensation commensurate to their work
2. Annual Fund to reach \$200,000 per year
3. Faculty Endowment Fund to reach \$50,000
4. Financial Aid Fund to assist 25% of families
5. Sentinel Society members to reach 75
6. Mortgage on the Remington Education Center to be retired
7. Structure and promotion of the planned giving program



PEOPLE DEVELOPMENT

1. Additional Faculty in Humanities, Math, Science
 - a. Increase full time roles
2. Increase the role and effectiveness of Principal (educational leader)
3. Increase the role and effectiveness of Marketing and Development department
4. Implement a more rigorous and faculty development program
5. Outdoor Education director
6. Chaplain, or spiritual life director
7. Increase college and career guidance and support
8. Increase and Strengthen Board of Directors



CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT

1. Research viability of utilizing town or local facilities as additional space
2. Phase 1 repairs and renewals of storage wings of Barn
3. Build a pergola or pavilion for an Outdoor classroom at current flagpole pavilion
4. Utilize and develop the Chester property as a science and outdoor learning center
