

New International Student Admissions & Enrollment Checklist

☐ STEP 1: REVIEW POLICIES

- Review Jesse Remington High School website to learn more about the school www.JRHS.org
- Review our Mission, Philosophy & Core Values

☐ STEP 2: APPLICATION

- Interview with the International Student Program Team Members and Headmaster
- Complete the Online Application include the following documents and pay Admission Fee of \$250
 - Copy of passport which is valid until the end of enrollment period
 - Copy of financial statement verifying the ability to pay the full tuition & fees
 - Copy of academic transcript and/or testing
 - Written Essay
 - Two References: One academic and one pastoral
- Interview with American Host Family and Headmaster
- Once you receive Notification of Acceptance move to STEP 3.

☐ STEP 3: ENROLLMENT: *required to receive Form I-20 from the School*

- Health & Medical required documents provided to Admissions.
 - i. A **Physical Exam** within the last 12 months is required. (In English)
 - ii. **Required Immunizations** MUST be completed before entering the country. The State of New Hampshire Immunization Requirements are listed [HERE](#)
 - iii. **Medical Release signed by parents or legal guardian.**
- Once you have received your I-20 move to STEP 4.

☐ STEP 4: Pay SEVIS & Apply for VISA:

- Pay the [I-901 SEVIS Fee](#). After receiving your Form I-20, you must pay the [I-901 SEVIS Fee](#). Federal regulations require all F1 students to pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee before applying for their U.S. student visa. You can pay your I-901 SEVIS Fee online at FMJfee.com or by using [Western Union Quick Pay](#). You must present the receipt as proof of payment when you apply for visa
- [Apply for your VISA](#). Attend VISA interview at the U.S. Embassy or Consulate where you apply. Documents you will need for interview:
 - i. Passport valid for travel to the United States
 - ii. Nonimmigrant Visa Application, [Form DS-160](#), confirmation page
 - iii. Application fee payment receipt, if you are required to pay before your interview
 - iv. Photo – You will upload your photo while completing the online Form DS-160. If the photo upload fails, you must bring one printed photo in the format explained in the Photograph Requirements.
 - v. Form I-20 – Your school will send you a SEVIS-generated Form I-20 once they have entered your information in the SEVIS database.

- After you have received VISA approval move to Step 5

□ **STEP 5: TUITION and TRAVEL**

- Pay balance of Tuition once your VISA is approved. The balance of Tuition must be paid within 10 days of VISA approval-- in full or half. If paid in half, remainder is due December 1st. Payment is to be made by Bank Transfer.
- Travel Arrangements are the sole responsibility of the Student's Family.
