## PART TIME STUDENTS – Tuition and Fees

Part time enrollment at Jesse Remington High School is available to accepted students wishing to take one or more classes at the high school level. Part time enrollment is based on course availability. Full time JRHS students have priority in course selection.

*\*Accepted: Both full time and part time students need to apply to JRHS and be accepted before enrolling.*

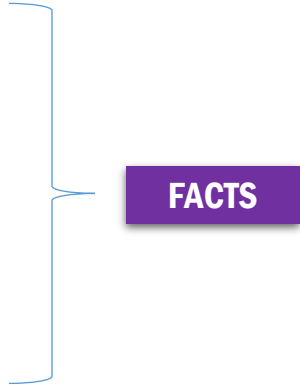
