
Bible

Entrepreneurial Education

This year-long program introduces students to the fundamentals of the entrepreneurial mindset, creativity, and problem-solving. Students engage in both in-class study and extracurricular activities aimed at sparking imagination and inspiring others. Throughout the year, they will develop skills in financial responsibility, managerial practices, teamwork, and the ability to learn from failure on their path to excellence.

Portfolio Evaluations

JRHS uses a form of semester evaluation called a Portfolio. As a high-order evaluation tool, the Portfolio focuses on content and application principles. The Portfolio serves to measure growth in a meaningful, relevant way and enable students to examine and evaluate their work and performance. The ongoing assessment inspires students to reach for new heights and facilitates scholarship, college, and job applications.

Project-Based Learning

Project Based Learning provides unique experiences that teach useful hard and soft skills. These courses change from year to year, offering new and different skills for our students. Students take five project classes each year, one each quarter plus a four-week January term. Many of these courses vary over time.

Humanities Faire

This is our first quarter project each year and involves the entire student body. Together, students create every aspect of a performance depicting the major players and places from one of these time periods: The Ancient World, Medieval Europe, Colonial America, Victorian Era, the Renaissance & Reformation, and the 20th Century United States.
