

Jesse Remington High School 2025-2026 Part-Time Program

Introduction to the Part-Time Program

Part-time enrollment at Jesse Remington High School is offered for homeschooling students who are interested in attending a high school but would like a period of transition between homeschooling and becoming a full-time student. Students may transition to full-time at any time during the school year or when enrolling for the next school year. We encourage part-time students to move to full-time as soon as possible and no later than the start of their Junior year.

Program Details

Part-time enrollment at Jesse Remington High School is available to accepted* students wishing to take one or more classes at the high school level. Transcripts will be made available for part-time students. Part-time enrollment is based on course availability. Full-time JRHS students have priority in course selection. A common part-time enrollment is the MWF or the TH Schedule, outlined below.

Part-time tuition is charged on a per-credit basis. All fees connected to a course will apply. See Full-time Student Information sheet for additional fees and payment terms.

*Accepted: both full-time and part-time students need to apply to JRHS and be accepted before enrolling.

- Project classes
 - \circ $\;$ Scheduled for Period 4 on Monday and Wednesday afternoons.
 - Each MWF student takes five project classes per year, one per quarter plus a 4-week January term project class.
 - Humanities Faire is the first quarter project class each year. Other project classes are chosen by students from options provided.
- Outdoor Education (OE): during Period 4 on Friday afternoons.
- Chapel: held on Friday mornings.
